Refunds and Transfers

The Gala Committee was very clear in stating early on that ticket refunds would only be given in cases involving an extreme emergency.

Due to the sellout of the Centennial Gala, the committee is researching viable avenues for a possible ticket exchange. This exchange would allow those who have purchased tickets and are unable to attend, to sell them to interested parties. Please stay

Gala Ticket Mail Out

Tickets and invitations will be mailed approximately 2 months prior to December 19. The committee will send tickets to the mailing address provided at the time of purchase. If a group table is purchased (seating for ten), all tickets will be sent to the table captain (the person who made the initial purchase). It then becomes the table captain's responsibility to track the names of the persons to be seated

Remember all proceeds from the auction will be designated to the Ocala Temple Renovation Project.




